This is a flagship event for Mangawhai Bowls with a full field every year with a waiting list. It is supported by bowlers from Far North, Northland, North Harbour, Auckland and Counties Manukau. It is, in the opinion of many of the ladies who play in it, "the best ladies' fours tournament" that they play in. Sponsorship \$3,000 plus GST.
- 3) The Magical Mangawhai any combination mixed fours. This tournament is scheduled to be held on 6/7/8 May 2022. This tournament is still in it's infancy and the format is yet to be finalised but we are confident of assembling a full field. Sponsorship \$3,000 plus GST.
